Better Cancer Support Through Consumers Call for Funding Applications



Cancer Australia and its funding partners invite interested community organisations to apply for funding under the *Building Cancer Support Networks Initiative: Better Cancer Support Through Consumers*.

This *Initiative* aims to reduce the burden of cancer through the provision of small grants to community organisations to aid in the coordination, accessibility and development of quality cancer support networks to better support people affected by cancer.

Applicants can apply for amounts of up to \$44,000 (GST inclusive) over a two year period under one category of the program:

1. Targeted Grants. These grants are provided in partnership with organisations that have agreed to contribute funding to a project that will build sustainable access to cancer support options.
 - i. These grants are funded through an Expression of Interest with partnering organisations
2. Capacity Building Grants. These grants will be provided to organisations which support innovative support networks; are linked to high priority areas such as rural and/or remote communities and/or specific Australian ethnic communities; and develop partnerships and provide a coordinated approach to cancer support.
 - i. These grants are funded through an Open Invitation to all applicants.
